2025 GGBA Annual Open Tournament Rules

1.) Eligibility: This is a USBC Sanctioned Tournament and will be governed by the 2025-2026 USBC rules and regulations, except as modified herein. Participants must be currently sanctioned, and applicants must present current USBC sanction cards at check in. **THIS TOURNAMENT IS OPEN TO ONLY CURRENT SANCTIONED BOWLERS IN THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.**

2.) TOURNAMENT ENTRY FEES: No Tournament Entry forms will be accepted without appropriate payment of fees. Entries must be paid in full at the time of turning in forms. Cash, Checks, Cashier's Checks, Money Orders are accepted for payments. (Make checks out to GGBA) Incomplete or illegible entries will not be accepted.

3.) AVERAGES:

- Entrants will use their highest 2024-2025 sanctioned league average of 21 games or more of any sanctioned adult winter league season. Averages of other types of leagues (Summer, Youth, etc.) will NOT be accepted.
- If not 24-25 average, entrants may use their current average of 21 games or more as of October 9th, 2025, of a sanctioned Adult winter season league. **Bowler is responsible for providing proof of average.**
- If no qualified average from the bullets above, the entrant shall bowl scratch, (zero handicap)
- 10 pin rule will be in effect for this tournament (Rule 319c (1))
- Failure to use correct average – all scores will be disqualified if the average is lower than the correct average. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.
- Prior tournament winnings will not need to be reported.

4.) HANDICAP: The Tournament will be conducted on a handicap basis. All averages will be computed on 100% of the difference between the entering average and 230. Averages 230 and above will bowl scratch (zero handicap)

5.) SUBSTITUTIONS & TARDY BOWLERS: Substitutions must be present 15-20 minutes prior to squad times. A tardy bowler will be permitted to bowl beginning with the frame being bowled when they arrive. The tardy bowler will be given a **ZERO** score for each frame missed.

6.) TEAM CAPTAINS: Team Captains must "check in" at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time to insure efficient Tournament Operations.

7.) MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:

- No more than 2 bowlers on the same team can bowl together more than once.
- Entrants bowling doubles must bowl singles, and vice versa.
- Doubles - A player may cash only once with the same partner but may cash as often as partners are changed.
- Singles – A player may cash only once in the prize list for position standing.
- The player's **first appearance** in each event counts towards All Events Placement.

8.) PRIZE FEES: Prize fees will be returned 100% in the form of checks or cash awards.

9.) SCORING & PROTESTS: Any scoring error must be reported immediately to any Tournament Official. Protests involving eligibility or playing rule violations must be filed in writing and delivered to a tournament official before tournament prize payments are made.

10.) The Tournament Committee will determine answers to questions not covered in the above rules.
